



# THE JOHN CARROLL SCHOOL

Every camper must submit all required forms, or they will not be allowed to participate in any camp activities. A medical provider will be awaiting the arrival of the campers under the canopy at the front of the school at drop-off. Please do not drop your camper off at John Carroll without the medical forms, and waivers or you will be asked to return to the school with the completed forms.

Please be advised that no medications (including over-the-counter medications like Tylenol or Advil) will be available to campers without an order from a bona fide prescriber and a completed Medication Administration Form.

Emergency medications, such as Epipens and inhalers may be self-carried, but a physician order is required to exercise this option. The camp medication authorization form can be found on the John Carroll Summer Program website.

Please ensure that your camper has a healthy breakfast. In addition, if the camp involves outdoor activities, please ensure the camper is adequately hydrated, carries additional fluids, and wears sunscreen.
