

## ***Archbishop John Carroll Service Honor Society***

### **ARTICLE I: NAME AND PURPOSE**

#### **Section 1.**

The name of this chapter shall be the Archbishop John Carroll Service Honor Society.

#### **Section 2.**

The purpose of the Society shall be to:

- a. inspire and recognize those students who have made outstanding contributions to society through direct service and community service;
- b. foster a dedicated spirit to ongoing direct and community service;
- c. further the contribution and depth of service of the society's members, as well as the school's entire student dedication to direct service;
- d. bring all manner of service to the attention of the school and community;
- e. increase an awareness of service in relation to areas of the school curriculum; and
- f. further service awareness in all aspects of the school's total program.

### **ARTICLE II : MEMBERSHIP**

#### **Section 1.**

Membership in this chapter shall be based upon service, and character. To be a member each recommended student must have given at least **100 hours of service including at least 25 hours of direct service as defined by the school**, and be of upstanding moral character.

#### **Section 2.**

To be eligible for selection to membership in this society, the candidate must have been enrolled at John Carroll for at least one year.

#### **Section 3.**

Candidates eligible for selection to this society have attended John Carroll for at least one year, and have a minimum GPA of 2.0. This level of achievement shall remain fixed.

### **ARTICLE III : SELECTION OF MEMBERS**

#### **Section 1.**

The selection of members to the Archbishop John Carroll Honor Society shall be by recommendation from the Outreach Coordinator and the faculty.

#### **Section 2.**

Any member whose GPA falls below 2.0 at mid quarter or quarter marking periods shall receive a warning. If during the next regular marking period of the school, the member fails to have a minimum GPA of 2.0.

### **Section 3.**

When a member is dismissed, he/she will be notified by the Society's Moderator. The membership pin and card will be returned to the Society.

## **ARTICLE IV: OFFICERS**

### **Section 1.**

The officers of this chapter shall be president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer. The chapter council shall consist of the president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, and the Society moderator.

### **Section 2.**

A majority of votes cast by members of the Society is necessary to elect officers of this Society. Elections will be held in the Spring for the next year.

### **Section 3.**

It shall be the duty of the president to preside at the meetings of this chapter.

### **Section 4.**

The vice president shall preside in the absence of the president, and serve as the chapter's program chair.

### **Section 5.**

The chapter secretary shall keep the minutes of the meetings, a record of all business, and all records on file.

### **Section 6.**

The treasurer shall receive and disburse all funds of the chapter and keep an accurate account of receipts and disbursements in accordance with school regulations.

## **ARTICLE V: SUPERVISION**

### **Section 1.**

The activities of this chapter will be subject to the approval of the moderator and the principal.

### **Section 2.**

The post of moderator shall be the Outreach Moderator

## **ARTICLE VI: MEETINGS**

### **Section 1.**

The regular meetings of this chapter shall be held during the school year on days designated by the chapter council.

### **Section 2.**

The officers of the chapter shall be elected at the last regular meeting of the year.

**Section 3.**

Special meetings, approved by the chapter council, may be called by the president.

**ARTICLE VII : Society Fundraising**

**Section 1.** The Service Honor Society shall sponsor fundraisers to provide money for operating expenses and for service projects.
